Wilkes University has committed itself to pay certain Dental, FSA, Telemedicine claims incurred under the terms of the plan.

## **Insurance Information**

The plan has insurance contracts with National Vision Administrators, United of Omaha Life Insurance Company and Family Service Association of Northeastern Pennsylvania to pay certain Vision, Long-term disability, Life insurance, AD&D, Voluntary Life & AD&D, EAP claims incurred under the terms of the plan. The total premiums paid for the plan year ending 12/31/2022 were \$277,438.
